

**Minutes of City Council
June 21, 2023
Board of Canvass**

The Council of the City of Lewisburg met to conduct a board of canvass on June 21, 2023 at 9:00 a.m. in the Paul R. Cooley Council Chamber at 942 Washington Street West for the purpose of canvassing the votes of the June 8, 2021 Municipal Election.

PRESENT: Mayor Beverly White, City Clerk Shannon Beatty, Council members Valerie Pritt and John Little.

CALL TO ORDER: Mayor White called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

Set amount for bond

Council member Little made a motion to set a bond in the amount of \$300 in the case of a recount request. Councilmember Pritt seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Certification of the votes

As required by West Virginia State Law, City Council canvassed the materials of the election.

One (1) Provisional ballot was cast and counted.

Councilmember Pritt made a motion to certify the total vote count For a four year Mayor term ending on June 30, 2027; 132 votes for Beverly White and for a four year term ending on June 30, 2027; 127 votes for John Little; 129 for Sarah Elkins.. Councilmember Little seconded the motion. The motion carried.
