June 17, 2019
Board of Canvass

CALL TO ORDER: Recorder Beatty called the meeting to order at 7:30 a.m.

9 Provisional ballots were cast, 8 were counted; 1 was not counted (as per the County Clerk, one person did not live in the city limits.) There were a total of 896 votes cast.
