## **ARTS & HUMANITIES FUNDING REQUESTS**

## LEWISBURG LITERARY FESTIVAL

Greg Johnson, Program Director for the Lewisburg Literary Festival presented the line up for the festival to be held August 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup>, 2023. There will be two venues during the festival, Carnegie Hall and Greenbrier Valley Theatre. Mr. Johnson stated in the past the city had awarded the festival \$8,000 towards the event.

Currently there is \$6,000 remaining in the Arts & Humanities Funding.

Council member Little made a motion to recommend to council to grant the Lewisburg Literary Festival \$3,000 this fiscal year. Mayor Whites seconded the motion. With all in favor the motion carried. Mr. Johnson was advised to apply in July for funding next fiscal year.
