

**City of Lewisburg
City Council
Special Session Minutes
Organizational Meeting
July 20, 2026, 10:00 a.m.**

PRESENT: Mayor White, City Councilmembers Paula Janiga, Franklin Johnson, John Little, Arron Seams and Valerie Pritt; Treasurer Susan Honaker, City Clerk Crystal Ratliff, Fire Chief Joseph Thomas, Police Chief Chris Teubert, and Public Works Director Tony Legg.

CALL TO ORDER: Mayor White called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.

**ADOPTION, READOPTION OR AMENDMENT OF RULES GOVERNING THE
OFFICIAL CONDUCT OF COUNCIL AND RULES GOVERNING THE
TRANSACTIONS OF COUNCIL BUSINESS:**

1. Robert's Rules of Order will be followed.
2. Mayor affirmed this Council's commitment to open meetings following the West Virginia Open Governmental Proceedings Act.
3. Mayor White's role at Council meetings would be to administer the meetings, and she shall be a voting member of City Council.
4. Council agreed to continue to offer an invocation but would strive to be open and inclusive of all faiths. Mayor White will lead the invocation unless a special guest has been invited to do so.
5. Council agreed to continue to recite the U.S. Pledge of Allegiance. Council member Pritt lead the pledge of allegiance.
6. Committee Chairs or their designee will give committee reports at the Council meetings.
7. Visitors may sign up before the Council meeting begin to speak at the Council meeting but limited to three minutes if not on the agenda. Speakers may defer their comments until the item is discussed on the regular agenda.
8. Council agreed to hold Finance Committee meetings at 7:00 p.m. on the Tuesday preceding the Council meeting in the Paul R. Cooley Council Chamber. City Council meetings will be held on the third Tuesday of the month at 7:00 p.m. The time and date for Public Safety Committee meetings will be announced as needed. Notices of regularly scheduled meetings will be posted on the front of City Hall.
9. The meeting focus will include full discussion of issues in a courteous, professional, and business-like manner with the encouragement of active discussion.

10. The administration and Council may invite the City Attorney to attend a Council meeting by using his or her best judgment in the use of public funds to pay for the attorney's presence.
11. Councilmembers wish to continue to receive as much information as possible through e-mail. No decision-making will occur through email.
12. Council will continue to be paid quarterly.

Councilmember Pritt made a motion, seconded by Councilmember Seams, to approve the adoption of rules governing the official conduct of Council and rules governing the transactions of council business. No further discussion. With all in favor motion carried.
